
THE 19TH MEETING OF THE FEDERAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, 2018







The Federal executive Council at its EC(2018)19th Meeting held on Wednesday, 6 June, 2018, had a valedictory session in honour of the former Minister of Mines and Steel Development, Dr. Kayode Fayemi, who recently resigned his appointment to contest for the Ekiti State Governorship position on the platform of the All Progressive Congress.
