<u>USE OF CONSULTANTS BY FEDERAL GOVERNMENT MINISTRIES.</u> <u>DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES</u>

Mr. President has directed your Office to issue a Service-Wide Circular requesting all Federal Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies ('MDAs') to submit a comprehensive list of all ongoing consultancy and outsourcing engagements currently contracted.

- 2. The submissions should include the following:
 - a. Name of consultancy firm stating if the entity is local or foreign;
 - b. Date the consultancy / outsourcing contract was awarded;
 - c. Tenure / period of the contract;
 - d. Fees payable to the consultants / outsourcing companies (including the currency of payment). For success / contingent fee mandates, the MDAs should provide an estimate of the expected payments to be made;
 - e. Brief description of the mandate (i.e. legal services, revenue / tax collection services, passport printing, fee collection, database / server and technology management, internet service provision, statutory audit, forensic accounting services, engineering / construction design, transaction advisory services, equipment procurement advice, service / maintenance, human resource consultancy services; etc.)
- 3. It is important to note that this directive only covers consultancy / outsourcing services and does not include capital expenditure procurements such as actual construction work. However, the consultancy services for such capital projects are included.
- 4. Mr. President has directed that all submissions should be made by 1st September, 2017 in both printed and electronic copies.
